



# Building Schools, Building Communities, Building Opportunities

#### MESSAGE FROM CEO CHARLES B. MCKENNA

This September marked the culmination of the makeover of the "New SDA," as a totally invigorated organization which delivers buildings on-time and on-budget. In September, the SDA opened six new schools and one addition/renovation marking a year in which more than 8,500 new seats were added around the state. New schools opened in Keansburg, Elizabeth, Jersey City, Paterson and Phillipsburg and an addition was opened in Bridgeton.



The Authority however, is not finished yet. Before the end of the year, schools in Gloucester City and Jersey City will be competed. We recently started work for new schools in Garfield, Newark, Trenton and Vineland and an addition/renovation project in New Brunswick. Also, we announced plans for new high schools in Camden and Perth Amboy. We have awarded construction contracts for new elementary schools in Harrison and Perth Amboy. Construction continues in Elizabeth, Passaic City, and West New York. And that does not take into account early site work, emergent projects and the work facilitated though the Regular Operating District grant program that is advancing throughout the State.

All of this work is the result of the incredible efforts of the SDA staff which is steadfast in its resolve to continue to deliver state-of-the-art learning facilities to children across New Jersey. Our Board of Directors continues to approve much needed projects and works diligently to ensure that the right projects move forward. We are collectively proud of our efforts and will continue to work hard to meet the ever growing demands of the children of New Jersey.

## **SCHOOL OPENINGS**

This September, students of New Jersey walked into seven new or significantly expanded facilities.

Combined with the two new schools opened earlier this year, SDA delivered nearly 8,500 new seats to New Jersey students. These projects represent a total State investment of \$553 million.

Schools that opened this September include Elizabeth Academic H.S./Frank J. Cicarell Academy, Jersey City Dr. Angelou School No. Maya 20. Keansburg Joseph C. Caruso E.S., Paterson Dr. Hani Awadallah E.S. School 16 Paterson No. Phillipsburg High School as well as a addition/renovation to Bridgeton Buckshutem Road E.S. The Newark Elliott Street E.S. and Oliver Street E.S. opened earlier this year.

## **ROD GRANTS**

The Regular Operating District (ROD) Grant program funds at least 40 percent of eligible costs for projects in the ROD districts Statewide. These projects generally address health and safety issues, as well as other critical needs that have a positive impact on student learning.

Since January 2010, the SDA has executed more than 2,129 grants providing \$631 million to local districts and leveraging projects estimated to total \$1.5 billion. A list of executed ROD Grant projects can be found on the <u>SDA website</u>.

There has been significant activity on the projects approved as part of the SDA's Capital portfolio. The status of the portfolio as of October 1, 2016 is:

**13** projects are complete;

- **10** projects are in active building construction;
- 2 projects have initiated design-build activity;
- 3 projects are in design-build procurement;
- 8 projects are in design development;
- 2 projects are in pre-design services phase; and
- **2** projects are in scope development.
