### **ROD Grants**

The Regular Operating District (ROD) Grant program funds at least 40 percent of eligible costs for projects in ROD districts Statewide. These projects generally address health and safety issues, as well as other critical needs, and have a positive impact on student learning.

Since January 2010, the SDA has executed 5,409 grants, providing an estimated \$6 billion to local districts and leveraging projects estimated at \$8.1 A list of executed ROD Grant projects can be found on the billion. SDA website.
