The New Jersey Schools Development Authority (“NJSDA”) seeks to engage a Microsoft Dynamics GP (Great Plains) Certified Solutions Provider for the SDA Offices located in Trenton, NJ and Newark, NJ. The solution provider should be prepared to provision Microsoft Dynamics GP Maintenance Services, Telephone Support, and Onsite Technical Services for Product Upgrades, Installations and/or Enhancements.

Proposals must be received by **12:00 PM on Thursday, September 26, 2008**, and may be mailed or hand delivered as set forth in the RFP.

Proposing firms must submit a true copy of their valid business registration certificate issued by the New Jersey Division of Revenue and complete a Moral Integrity Questionnaire.

**Evaluation Criteria:** Submissions that are not responsive will be rejected without evaluation. Responsive submissions will be ranked pursuant to the following evaluation criteria:

In addition, to be selected, a firm must be approved for moral integrity, pursuant to a review by the NJ State Police, as set forth in the RFP.
