

Requirements for participation include:

- •A valid NJ Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue Business Registration
- •A valid NJ State License when required by trade
- •A valid NJ Department of Labor, Division of Wage and Hour Compliance Public Works Contractor Registration
- •Company must be in business for a minimum of 3 years
- •A physical location in the State of NJ
- •One or more full time employee(s), excluding the owner
- •No personal felonies and/ or criminal convictions or state debarments that have not been satisfied
