Christie Administration Opens Seven New Or Renovated Schools This September Openings Deliver New Seats for 6,619 Students

TRENTON, NJ – Through the implementation of an efficient and effective school construction program, the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA) is opening six new and one renovated schools to students this week. These new and renovated facilities will provide 6,619 additional seats for students throughout New Jersey.

"This September, students in all parts of this state will be walking into new or renovated schools, opening the door to first-rate learning facilities that give them the tools necessary to achieve academic success," said SDA CEO Charles McKenna.

The seven completed school projects represent a state investment of more than \$432.7 million. The school openings include two new high schools (Phillipsburg High School and Elizabeth High School-Frank J. Cicarell Academy); four new elementary schools (Jersey City Public School #20, Keansburg Caruso Elementary School, Paterson Dr. Hani Awadallah School and Paterson School #16); and one addition/renovation (Bridgeton Buckshutem Road School).

"The opening of these facilities is a testament to the success that has been achieved during this new era of a responsible and accountable school construction program implemented under the Christie Administration," Mr. McKenna said. "Over the next month, we will join with the School Districts at ceremonial ribbon cuttings, highlighting the positive impact that the State's investment and work of the SDA has had on these communities."

Earlier this year, the SDA had announced that construction of two new schools in Newark were completed ahead of schedule, allowing students and staff to move into their new facilities for a portion of the 2015-2016 school year. The new Elliott Street School and Oliver Street School provide 1,864 new seats to students in Newark. The state's investment in these two projects is \$120.3 million.

All of these schools were designed incorporating the guidelines developed by the United States Green Building Council (USGBC) known as the "Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design ("LEED®") program in order to achieve maximum energy efficiency and environmental sustainability in the design of schools.

SDA's portfolio of September school openings includes projects that were built using either a traditional design-build approach or design-build approach. The design-build method differs from the traditional approach by allowing the SDA to contract with one firm for both design and construction of a school facilities project. The design-build method also allows for some design and construction activities to proceed concurrently through phased advancement, an approach that potentially allows for improvement upon the original overall schedule.

The SDA's current portfolio of active projects is valued at more than \$2 billion – including the Capital Project Portfolio, emergent projects and Regular Operating District grants.
