## **New Jersey Schools Development Authority Announces Margate City School District to Receive More Than \$1 Million in Grant Funding for School Improvement Project**

**Trenton, NJ** – In support of the Murphy Administration’s commitment to ensuring students receive a world-class education in a first-rate learning environment while relieving the pressure on local taxpayers, the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA) today announced that a grant has recently been executed for the Margate City School District through the SDA’s Regular Operating District (ROD) grant program. Grant execution signifies completion of the application process and the start of funding being issued to school districts through the SDA’s ROD grant program.

“Through our partnership with local school districts, this funding helps to ensure all students and school staff members across the State have access to high-quality learning environments that support positive learning outcomes. By addressing important school building upgrade projects, we are creating safe, healthy facilities for generations of young learners,” said SDA CEO Manuel Da Silva.

This grant is part of the \$450 million in grant funding announced by the SDA and New Jersey Department of Education in September 2023. Funding for this school construction initiative was made possible through legislation and grant funding from SDA allocations. Between state and local contributions, the total project costs of the eligible projects across the state are estimated to exceed \$1 billion. This significant investment impacts hundreds of local communities around the state by helping districts leverage resources to pay for important school facility projects while continuing to bolster the State’s construction industry.

The project in Margate City School District represents \$2.6 million in total estimated costs including a state grant of more than \$1 million, which leverages the local contribution of more than \$1.5 million. The SDA has executed more than \$8.8 million in grants to the Margate City School District since the start of the State’s school construction program.

The grant will provide funds for building upgrades including lighting upgrades, boiler and HVAC unit replacements, as well as updates to HVAC controls at William H. Ross III Intermediate School.

The state-grant program funds at least 40 percent of eligible costs for projects in the RODs, addressing health and safety issues and other critical needs.
