## SDA IN REGULAR OPERATING DISTRICTS (ROD) *What SDA funding is available for ROD Districts?*

### **FISCAL YEAR EMERGENT AND CAPITAL MAINTENANCE FUNDING**

The New Jersey State FY 2022 and FY2023 budgets included a direct appropriation of \$75 million to the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA) to provide funding for projects related to emergent and capital maintenance needs. The funding is available to offset district costs associated with taking those important measures and ensuring students have safe and healthy learning environments.

Districts are able to obtain this funding through submitting a certification signed by the District Superintendent or Business Administrator stating that the funds provided will be used by the district for an appropriate purpose and lists the projects for which the funds would be appropriately utilized.

### **REGULAR OPERATING DISTRICT GRANTS**

The New Jersey State FY2023 budget included a direct appropriation of \$350 million to the New Jersey Schools Development Authority (SDA) to provide funding for grant projects. The specifics of the program will be announced prior to the end of 2022, however it is expected to follow a similar process as earlier allocations.

School districts are eligible to receive at least 40 percent of eligible project costs. For a school facilities project to be considered for grant funding, the proposed scope of work must be 100 percent eligible for State support. Only projects that are 100 percent eligible for state support and included in the identified prioritization level will be considered by DOE, although districts may request debt-service aid for other projects.
