However, it is not anticipated that successful firms will be asked to apply for or obtain environmental permits in connection with SDA School Facilities Projects.

2. **Question:** Is it possible to obtain a waiver for the insurance requirements listed in the RFP? Specifically, I am interested in knowing if a waiver can be obtained for Commercial General Liability Insurance and Network Security/Cyber/Privacy Breach Insurance.

**Answer:** The SDA will not alter or waive any of the insurance requirements set forth in the RFP.
